We recruit widely, from mainstream schools and academies at all phases, as well as from special schools, alternative provisions and from the independent sector. We have an outstanding success rate with 98% of submissions to final assessment awarded the qualification.

HOW THE PROGRAMME IS STRUCTURED

- Pre and post course 360
- Induction day
- Face-to-Face days - 5 days addressing all curriculum content and assessment framework requirements. Core taught modules are delivered over twelve months and include pre and post day online tasks, readings, work-based activities and reflection.
- Each day integrates delivery of assessment outcomes and learning behaviours
